Within the space of eight months I sat holding the hand of both my parents as they passed on to the other side. Someone said to me that when you lose a loved one, time suddenly stands still. I can attest to this – with the addition that when you lose two loved ones close together, time actually seems to start going backwards!

A week after dad went – actually the evening of his funeral, I was battling with those pesky mind-messing flashbacks of the lead-up to both their deaths ... (mum left us in a great deal of pain, and the experience of dad's departure was extremely unpleasant as some terrible hallucinations dominated his final days). On this particular evening, something popped into my noggin – in amidst the flashbacks. My mind shifted to the actual moment of death for both my parents – that fragile split second that separates us from our mortal life. It suddenly struck me very strongly just how gentle, compassionate and almost overwhelmingly kind and peaceful death itself is – and I couldn't help thinking of Celesta, and this episode's portrayal of that moment of death. The light, gentle touch which carries a soul from this world to the next; the calm, slow-motion passing from this life; and the love for the living that death has.

I picture this often now – and it is strangely comforting.



Leather Wardrobe is made of vinyl soft leather like material and lined with soft cotton material and all decorations are hand painted. All the designs are Egyptian especially with the Egyptian eyes and what seems to me to be Isis in the front. It consists of a set of gauntlets, a dress and a set of greaves.





6. Piece of cloth with a dragon



7 & 8 Amazon Mask and elaborate necklace, the large medallion is 3" across, the middle one is 2 1/2" and the smallest one is 2".





9. Here are 2 daggers, one is a standard dagger the other is a FX dagger that holds a blood tube in the handle so you can squeeze it a little as you cut someone and have the blood cut appear. It has a thin tube with holes in it that runs the full length of the blade but the holes are only from the tip to about half way down. The handles are made of closed cell foam with a resin coating and then painted but the blades are rubber, neat little daggers measuring 9" long that look identical in appearance.










