Last issue we talked about the tremendous abuse in the COA business and to be careful and do research!! Lots of props and wardrobe that have changed hands over the years are very susceptible to added embellishments and “Stories” that are just not true so the item can be sold for a good price. Since COAs are only as valuable as the source they are derived from, make sure you trust the seller. However in my case I bought a very expensive prop from a trusted seller and it still turned out to originate from a scam!

Here is my story, a very condensed version.

I, Barbie Arms, had purchased a chakram from what we shall call **Seller** on April 11, 2006, and I will call myself chakram owner number **Two** since the story has many facets and identities are not disclosed other than mine. Seller told me they purchased some items from Anthony Launer a man who won “A Day with Xena” with his family back in the summer of 1997 during filming of “The Bitter Suite” and in doing so seller found out about this chakram Anthony had. One of the articles about the Launer’s visit to the set said they were invited into Lucy’s trailer where Lucy handed **a** (one) chakram to Anthony’s daughter. Seller bought a chakram, this chakram from supposedly Mr. Launer in September 2003 and was willing to sell the chakram to me in 2006 and of course I was very interested! Well I initiated correspondence back and forth vigorously with endless questions for 3 months with seller trying to validate the “Day With Xena” and the facts surrounding the chakram and that they actually paid for the chakram into Mr Launer’s account, and that it was the chakram Lucy handed to Mr. Launer’s daughter. The pictures and paperwork all seemed to match up and of course my biggest piece of the puzzle was that I trusted the source. So I bought into what I now know to be a huge scam, how did this happen to me?

There is a scammer lurking around every corner and a trusting soul to match, someone was posing as Mr. Launer or he was *involved* in the scam somehow himself we are not sure at this point investigations by chakram owner number **one** continue. It is heartbreaking to not have what you thought and well a big chunk of money hurts too! This all came under scrutiny because a chakram that looked very much like mine we will call chakram owner number **Three** came up on ebay with the same story attached to it "A Day with Xena" and the same clear stones as mine which I thought was for special effect but the wolf said they only used paua shell and nothing else!!

Seems as Lucy was handing out chakrams like candy, NOT. I also found out about another collector during this auction (yes we were coming out of the woodwork) we will call owner number **One** who also has a chakram with this same story attached to it with pictures and articles. I guess I was a bit naïve to think I could have access to such a gem but It definitely brought me down to earth and know that collecting is challenging and fun but heartbreaking at times also.

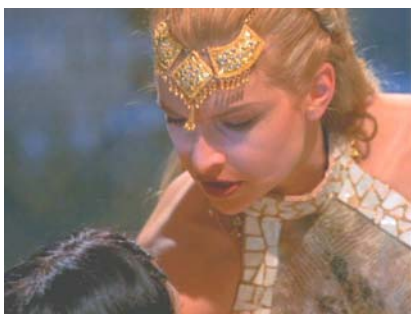
This owner number **One** had email communications with Seller discussing the chakrams and indicating that Seller or owner number **One may** have been the recipient of a scam on August 28, 2005 **before** Seller sold me my chakram in 2006. Here is what owner number **One** says.....

"I wrote to Seller because I saw they were selling a chakram with the same story as mine. Seller did write back to me a while later to ask me if I thought the guy was a scammer and said perhaps he had acquired more than one chakram (I just checked my old e-mails to recall this). Seller said they checked the scammer lists and his name was not on it"

Seller's actual reply.....

*" I got mine from a guy who sent me pics that had him and his family with Lucy on set. He even sent me pics of the clippings of him in the magazine. He did tell me he did get quite a bit of stuff, **so he may have gotten more than one chakram?** I've had no other reports about this guy from anyone else and he isn't on the current scammers list. **But who knows.** Did he say anything to you that would have led you to believe him as a scammer?"*

Speechless..... To sell a chakram to someone knowing it **could** be a scam, **"He may have gotten more than one chakram?"** checking scam lists saying **"But who knows?"** and knowing there are at least two now with the same "Day with Xena" story all under question? Guilt by omission, this NEVER came up in 3 months of asking seller questions.

Seller did respond about this after I approached them back in December 2006 when the Wolf said they never used anything other than Paua shells in the

chakrams and mine has clear round stones. Seller just recapped the story of how they got the chakram and in the body of the email made this statement.....

“I could never say for sure it is a genuine chakram”.

What? Seller signed 2 COAs saying it was set used by Lucy Lawless?

Recent emails in June 2007 from me to seller after I knew they sold me a fake chakram turned up a response that they really feel bad about what happened but do not remember the email exchange with chakram owner number **One** back in 2005, what? they don't remember? Wow, that email above from a collector approaching me regarding the possibility of a scam about my prop and there are now two with the same “A Day with Xena” story would burn in my brain! where there is smoke there is fire.

In Part One of Blind faith I talked about how a seller should take responsibility once a document is handwritten or signed by that seller describing a prop and or placing it in a specific episode or in this case “incident”. The responsibility of authenticity should be with that seller regardless of the origin because they threw themselves into the ring. If the seller or buyer finds out later, months or years down the road that the prop is not as stated on the COA the seller should be willing to buy back the prop as the document is now fraudulent hence the transaction no longer valid. Even if a seller innocently passed on the document with incorrect information, it does not change that the document is still fraudulent that they took responsibility for it with their signature. Seller did just that typed up a letter and a COA signed them both regarding history and origin of the chakram from “A Day with Xena” visit, set used by Lucy lawless, all after having a discussion with another collector that had the same chakram with the same story? Collectors if you are not sure 100% about a prop or wardrobe please don't pass along a made up COA they are very damning to you and will come back to haunt you. A buyer that may be new to the prop world puts their complete trust in you. Just tell them everything you believe about the prop and just pass along what paperwork you got when you bought it. If you offer a Letter of Authenticity to state where the prop came from and who the current owner will be like you are presenting it to them that is fine just type your name on it and don't sign it. Only sign documents reflecting props that you are **sure** about. That way the buyer can make the decision to buy the prop knowing without a signature there may be no recourse on the item. If you are sure about the prop or wardrobe then do sign it. The buyer will now have the ease and open door to go back to the seller and feel free to discuss any problems that may arise requiring investigation about that item. Those that have nothing to hide, hide nothing. If you sign a document be prepared to buy the item back **if solid** evidence proves it is not what was on your signed COA.

Knowing the chakram was not as stated on my COAs I still had pictures sent to the man that created Xena's chakram, Roger Murray AKA the Black Wolf and he said after viewing my chakram it was not one he or his production team ever made for use on the Xena set. The real one is still out there! Too bad the owner of the REAL one may have a hard time ever selling it when they choose to, shows how damaging these scammers are to the collecting world.

Believe me I do not take pleasure in all of this but a new day is dawning the "Twilight of the Gods" are upon us!

1. Here is a large, long, heavy metal sword with a scorpion-like arachnid as the handle. It was acquired from It's A Wrap, post the Yahoo auctions. There was no ID tag on it. It may have been used in Hercules.



2. Here is the familiar looking sword that we've seen in so many episodes such as Draco's sword, Deimos' sword, "The Xena Scrolls" and Petracles sword, but this one is in gold, which I don't recall seeing. Maybe used in a Hercules episode?

3. Here is an awesome-looking sword with several skulls making up the handle. It did come with a studio tag attached that reads "Hells Blade", but nothing telling what show/episode it was from. Again may be from Hercules.



4. Horse Head Staff, It is the same cast horse head we see as the handle to the magic Amazon dagger from the episode "Lifeblood", but this horse-head is atop a long gnarled wooden staff.



5. Lucy Lawless Hot Pants, The original It's A Wrap-Yahoo auction description read: "A sexy little pair of Hot Pants worn by Lucy Lawless as Xena, they are made of brown leather with brown

leather petals and right side brown leather lace up. This collectible is accompanied by a custom Costume Department label that reads "Xena, Lucy". Item #7133."
I suppose for anyone that wondered what Xena wore under her brown leathers, this may answer the question but I just don't recall ever seeing it.

New reader Shelley wants to know

Q Where did the idea or origin of the Bird for the Amazon Sword Hilt come from? Also it looks almost identical to this popular balancing bird toy made back in the 90's. Look at the tail shape, wing shape with lines for feathers and head shape similarities below!



A Consider the following about the symbolism of eagles in ancient times and belief systems. Firstly shamanism - which as we know in the Xenaverse was practiced by the Northern Amazons, but seemingly not by the Greek Amazons, though presumably there were some shared influences. Shamanism actually covers a multitude of belief systems, all of which share in common the belief in the power of nature and in the existence of parallel plains of consciousness. The symbolism of the eagle in shamanism is variable from one area to another, with the common factor being that it is seen as the highest form of power, being the closest to the spirit and spiritual healing.

In ancient Greece, eagles were a common symbol for supreme spiritual energy. For example - Zeus was attended to by an eagle, and an eagle carried souls to Hades.

Within other cultures the eagle represented such concepts as royalty, power, authority, victory, fertility, storms, lightning, and is commonly the antithesis of the serpent, plus the double-headed serpent (Garudabird) was worshipped by the Hittites as a symbol of omniscience.

On the other hand, it was also identified with the Zu bird - a storm demon and worker of disaster and evil. Thank you **Lilias** liliasodell@yahoo.co.uk

Q I wanted clarity on the use of the term "hero" in regard to collecting. I feel that some folks think that "hero" = "worn/used by the Lead". But in reading definitions on prop collecting sites it seems that the term "hero" applies to the quality of the prop/costume, and not necessarily who wore/used it? **Mark** jack_deth13@yahoo.com

A Hero: A type of prop or wardrobe that is regarded as the type of highest and best use; often attributed to use by the star or a principal of the production as well as close-up shots. 1) The "hero" prop is not the "stunt" version or "special fx" version, or any other special/specific use version of the prop; 2) the "hero" version of the prop is frequently the most highly detailed and/or functional and is usually (though not always) made of superior materials (i.e. metal vs. rubber or

resin) and of a higher quality of workmanship; 3) the "hero" version of the prop is frequently intended for use in close-up shots and/or publicity material; 4) the "hero" version of the prop is frequently used by the star/lead of the film; 5) in terms of collecting, "hero" props command a premium in price, value, rarity, and demand. **Jason De Bord**
