The Wolf says special effects props are a one-off item!

This is Xena’s metal retractable sword for special effects. You can see the line about 1/3 the way up from the blade tip. This was meant to retract back inside the sword for stabbing a person. The swords made for sticking up out of trees or the ground would have a projection on the end.

Xena sword cut off. Notice the odd shaped end. This must have been shaped to slip into something to hold it straight up or sideways and confirms that these cut off versions were made for a particular scene and are therefore a one-off prop.

1. Special effects sword with a pump at the hilt and a tube running down to the blade. Mark thinks the pump was to squirt out blood from the blade. Below you can see the bulbous spot on the center of the handle. This is a depressible air-pump that forces air pressure out the slits along the edge of the blade. Below you will see there is also a cut off version.

2. Xena Special Effects Whip

The handle is resin and identical to Xena's trademark leather whip. The length of this whip is longer than her standard one, and within the braided leather is a steel cable. You can see one of the looped ends of the cable protruding from the end of the handle - this was to fasten onto the body harness of Xena, and the other looped end of the cable, protruding from the end of the whip, would latch onto whatever Xena was swinging from, usually a tree.

These are 3 pics are of a severed head with a 1/2 hinge on his neck....this prop was probably used in decapitation scenes such as with a sword chop or guillotine to were the head would drop as if being cut. If you notice the eyes are looking up a little as if the person was on his knees or laying down looking up. It is banged up a little so you know it had a lot of use.



The next 2 pics are a head that has his eyes shut and mouth drooping like it is dead, it has a hole in the bottom of the neck to were it could have been on the end of a stake, or staff...similar to when you would see Xena walking up to a town where warriors killed the villagers and hung them and body parts on stakes as warnings to all who entered.



The next few pictures are of an anatomically correct female doll. When she arrived in the bottom of a box of body parts from the set she had a ring of adhesive on her head to hold a hat or cap on. Her face and neck were painted a lighter pale flesh color. When I tried to clean the adhesive off, the paint starting coming off also...so I just took the rest of it off. I can't be sure she was used as Eve in 'Eternal Bonds' can't say she wasn't either...but it looks like the one Ares is holding in the screen cap below.....I think I can hope it is anyway!

Q How difficult is it to put together a complete costume, and what do collectors consider "complete" to be? All wardrobe including footwear, jewelry, etc. or can a costume be complete in some other way? Also, how important to collectors is it to have complete costumes? **Gretchen**

A 1 I think it would be nearly impossible at this point to assemble a complete costume piece by piece (now that everything is scattered to the four directions); the best way was to try to get a complete costume all together. But even this was impossible to do when trying to obtain Xena or Gab hero costumes from the official source -- It's A Wrap had broken up the costumes into separate auction lots (Xena = armor + leather dress + boots). Gab's red boots were separated from her BGSB costumes as well. You had to win all of the lots that seemed to go together to get a complete costume. The Gabrielle Amazon Queen costume was sold as nearly complete (it is missing a purple under skirt and the Queen mask). The Evil Xena costume from the Herc Trilogy was missing the dagger from its sheath and Xena's white knobbed swords, but everything else is there.

Some will not consider a costume complete unless you have the character's weapon of choice as well, so for Gab you would need an actual Gabstaff or a pair of Sais, depending on which season's costume you were working with. For Xena, you would need her sword and chakram (either design) and for Callisto and Ares, you would need their swords. Others won't care as much about the weaponry but will want to make sure that any jewelry a character wore is there, such as Ares' earring, pendant, and ring. **CHRIS CLOGSTON**

A 2 In terms of what constitutes a complete costume there is some debate because of the way in which the costumes were kept by Pacific Renaissance and sold off. In the world of wardrobe, it seems, footwear and headwear were often kept separate from the rest of the costume, and even accessories were sometimes separated. For this reason when the wardrobe was auctioned off in many cases the costumes were auctioned as complete when they had the main body of the costume, although jewelry, shoes and helmet (for example) were not included. The auctions included variations on completeness as well, where some 'complete' costumes did have the accessories/jewelry (but no foot or headwear) and some 'complete' costumes in fact had every single piece, head to toe. As a result of this, many collectors who later resold the items they bought at auction, offered them as 'complete' regardless of what the situation was since that was how they received it.

Nevertheless, I would have to say that the only true state of completeness is when all pieces as worn by the actor from head to toe are present. I would also venture to say that finding costumes in this state of completeness is rare. The Xena Museum has a number of costumes in this state of completeness but more often many costumes are only complete to the extent of everything but the shoes. That state of complete - everything but shoes - seems to be the most likely state of completeness in which one hopes to find a costume and I think that it would be fair to collectors to consider this complete in its way.

There are also many costumes that might be considered complete as worn in one scene or episode even though the truly complete costume with many additional pieces was worn at other times. This is the case, for example, with Gabby's Amazon Queen costume and Xena's Shamaness costume. There are episodes where the actresses are seen wearing just the main body of the costumes without any or most of the accessories. So I would say that they can be considered complete since they were seen on screen worn that way. They are the complete costume as it was seen in a particular scene.

Difficulty in obtaining a complete costume varies. If it was sold by the studio as complete it may have stayed intact and one may be able to purchase it intact, for a price. It is unfortunate but must be pointed out that quite a few costumes that were sold complete by the studio were broken up by the owners and resold in parts.

More likely one may find a costume that is without shoes and headwear (for the reasons explained above) and even without jewelry. But whatever state of incomplete the costume may be in, it can be a long time searching far and wide to try and piece the costume together to be complete. I can say from personal experience that it is a difficult task. It can be done and the Museum has accomplished it at times but as one can see from reading Xena Prop House, the Museum as well as the many avid collectors in the XPH community are still searching for items needed to complete costumes.

The importance of completeness I would say is a matter of personal preference. I know many collectors who never set out to obtain complete costumes. In some cases budget was the reason but for many they were more happy getting just one iconic costume piece or prop from each favorite costume, scene, episode or character. The Xena Museum has complete costumes but also has gone the route of having just the iconic item or two to represent a certain character or what have you. I think there are also other issues - all matters of personal preference to some extent - that may have more importance to some collectors than completeness alone. For example, as we have come to learn, there were nearly always duplicates of every costume made. There were duplicates for the star and others for the stunt doubles, riding doubles and body doubles. Frequently, but not always, the items were labeled to say who was to wear them and so you would have costumes marked Lucy or Renee or the name of a double or just the word double, etc. For many collectors, they would much rather have an incomplete costume that is entirely labeled as worn by Lucy than have a complete one which is labeled for a stunt double. Condition may also be an issue of more or less importance, in the eyes of the beholder. Some collectors may prefer an incomplete costume in perfect condition over a complete one that is badly worn or damaged. While personal preferences play a strong role in this, we can look objectively at prices people pay as a marker of importance and most certainly a complete costume, labeled as worn by Lucy or Renee, in excellent condition is the most expensive to obtain. **CHRISTINA**
