Eye of the Beholder Part 2 H1 E 2



Last Issue the question presented to readers was if changing a prop or wardrobe in any way is a huge irresponsible action or does it have its place? Will it render the prop less valuable or increase the value? I was very interested how you feel about altering props and wardrobe and posted **every** response I received here below. Thank you all for taking the time to respond, it is very interesting to see your thoughts on this.

A 1 I think the subject of restoring props will always be hotly debated...but it really comes back to what the perceived value is for each individual collector. This could include monetary value but in general it usually means emotional/personal significance, which is always different for each person. If you are in the business of reselling props and your goal is to turn a profit, then you may be better off leaving a prop in its "set-used" condition. This leaves the option of altering a prop to the buyer, and as a buyer, I prefer to purchase items as they came off the set. Also as a buyer, I expect a certain amount of "set wear" to be present. After all, part of the significance of owning a genuine prop is that the prop was most likely used in production. And, it's a lot of fun to find a prop or wardrobe piece onscreen that you can match to something in your collection.

Once you have a prop in your possession, you are the owner and you get to make that choice. If someone has already decided for me, then the prop holds less value to me personally, but this could be because I buy props for myself, for my own collection, and not for resale. However, I don't have a hard and fast rule for any prop I am considering for purchase. I look at each item on a case by case basis to decide. If it is something I have been seeking for a long time, or it is that

one last piece of an outfit that I need, I may buy it regardless because it means something to me personally. However, in any case, I want to know exactly what has been done to a prop before I make my decision to buy it. I feel that is my right and sellers should be forthcoming with that information. If I have a prop in my collection already and it looks like it needs some repairing or restoring, I again make that decision on a prop by prop basis. In general, I like to keep items in their set-used condition, and instead put effort into protecting them from deteriorating further by having an appropriate display and/or storage method. But I wouldn't be adverse to the idea of using something like seamstress tape to hold together a tear that could become more significant if I leave it as it is, or as Barbie mentioned, keeping a rubber dagger in a sheath to prevent it from curling further. In that case, I would consider the repairs preventive, rather than proactive. But I would be afraid to apply glue, dismantle a piece, or use other types of repair methods because the risk of destroying or damaging it further wouldn't be worth the risk.

As for using pieces of props or wardrobe, I have a large amount of Gabrielle's sixth season fabric that I purchased along with her bra and it is obviously leftover from the pattern. I've used it as background for some of my display cases, and love the way it ties into the display. I would never cut a piece off of another costume to do this, but extra fabric from the wardrobe dept is still actual set material, it's just leftover material, so using it in displays is a good way to utilize it rather than having it sit in the bottom of a box somewhere.

A 2 I agree that Props (i.e., swords) should not be signed, even by Lucy, Kevin or Renee, as it takes away from the prop. Inside a shirt, however, is cool. **Randi A. Sarokoff, Ph.D., BCBA**

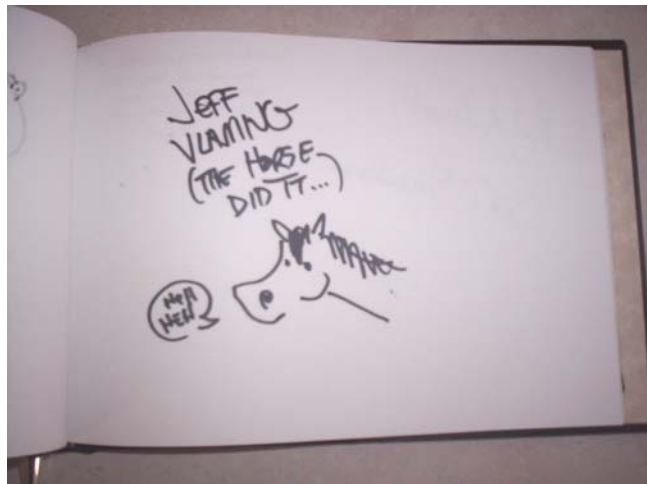

Prince Hercules boots worn by Kevin's stunt double, Patrick Kake, who in recent years has earned a name for himself as an actor: among various roles, he was Oreius the Centaur in the movie [The Chronicles of Narnia: The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe](#) .

Having watched the It's A Wrap-Yahoo auctions obsessively, Mark recalls seeing the Prince Hercules cossie selling, minus the boots. It wasn't until the It's A Wrap warehouse sale (post auctions) that he found the boots in a big container of various boots/shoes. The boots were mostly shipped in separate containers, which may explain why many cossies were sold without their respective footwear.

The boots are practically mint, so Patrick must not have had much action in that episode. The two boots are tied together and the studio tag reads "Prince Herc" and labels inside both boots have Patrick Kake's name. Watching the episode you'll see these are definitely the boots for the costume, they are black leather and lace up the sides rather than the front.

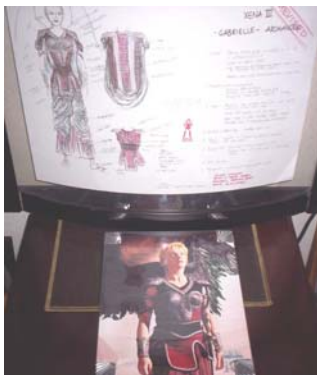

Q How do you decide what the focus of your collection will be? Is it based on the look of the item (whether or not you are just attracted to the item itself), the episode it was used in, the character that used it, financial considerations, or other factors? **Tedra**

A I choose pieces of my collection based on how much I like the piece and/or if it was used in an episode or by a character that I especially like. For set dressing pieces, I don't care which episode it was used in; I will purchase just about any set dressing piece if it appeals to me, and pass on the ones that don't. I do the same for weapons of any kind, especially swords and daggers, unless it is a weapon that goes with a specific costume that I have. The prop and wardrobe department did such a lovely job on everything, but much in the same way you go into a clothing or furniture store, certain pieces catch your eye and appeal to you, and others don't. Wardrobe is a little different. I am partial to certain types of wardrobe, and especially love Amazon items, all equestrian items, Valkyrie items, and Roman costumes, so I will usually seek those out first. But with any prop, wardrobe, set dressing piece, or any other item, it's like looking at a catalog: Show me everything that you have for sale, and I'll probably find something interesting that I want. Finances are always a consideration, but I'm willing to try to do what I can to purchase an item if it's something that I really love. The short answer is I guess I don't really have a focus in my collection, I just buy pieces that appeal to me and try to display/arrange them

in a way that looks interesting and protects the pieces. There were so many episodes and characters that I liked; it's nice to have a variety of items in my collection. **MORGAN**

A I have gone through many changes during my prop collecting but I currently buy props according to the source and how appealing it is to me. Originally I had an affinity for the swords and could not get enough of them but I turned the corner at some point and decided to include wardrobe in my collection. I prefer acquiring props privately rather than auctions and am game for any prop that has appeal to me in some way. I will not pass up an opportunity to buy a prop than can help complete or compliment props I already have. I have been very interested lately in set dressing items to help create an atmosphere that helps the items “make sense” and meld better into my display room. I am very interested in preserving these props by either displaying them or keeping them neatly hung in my closets. Nothing I own currently sits in a box or is in any kind of storage. I absolutely love spears and staffs but gosh DARN they are a bear to ship!
