

It is made of a vinyl soft leather like material and lined with soft cotton material and all decorations are hand painted. All the designs are Egyptian especially with the Egyptian eyes and what seems to me to be Isis in the front. It consists of a set of gauntlets, a dress and a set of greaves.

10. Here are 2 daggers, one is a standard dagger the other is a FX dagger that holds a blood tube in the handle so you can squeeze it a little as you cut someone and have the blood cut appear. It has a thin tube with holes in it that runs the full length of the blade but the holes are only from the tip to about half way down. The handles are made of closed cell foam with a resin coating and then painted but the blades are rubber, kinda neat little daggers measuring 9" long that look identical in appearance.

Has anyone seen these daggers?



11. Here is a material, leather, beaded, feather headband. It has a feathered type wing look on each side with gold beads all the way around and fastens in the back with two long braided leather ties. It is labeled on the inside with a marker 'Artemis'.....but is it from Hercules or Young Hercules.. don't recall seeing Artemis in XWP with a light colored outfit, seems like she always had black or dark brown outfits with that pointed or horned looking headpiece. It is very well made so it probably is a lead item.





Here are Lucy's stunt boots and they come with the IAW COA showing that they are Lucy's with a label. Something else to be said about these boots- Lucy herself advertised these boots on her site stating them to be hers, as they were auctioned off for charity, along with quite a few other props and costumes of hers at the time. They are also her size so even though we know they aren't her hero boots, we know she obviously did some stunts on horseback, and these are equestrian boots. Lucy wore these English equestrian boots when she did limited stunt work on top of Tilly (Argo) the beautiful palomino mare she rode throughout the series. The boots are actually black painted brown to go with her brown leathers. They are a size 10 1/2 (her size) and are a rubber material not leather like her normal boots. \$150



4. Arch Angel Sword






Holly's Story:

The first week of December in 2007 I had gone outside to let my chickens out from their pen for a run around in the backyard. As I always do I would go and check up on them every few minutes to make sure they were all right but this time when I went outside I decided to go and collect their eggs. So I walked into their pen and from the corner of my eye I saw this white flash and when I turned around it was a tiny kitten. The way my pen is set up there is a small section where the pen is up against the fence and only something very tiny could squeeze through there and that is where this cute little kitten was sitting but looked very squashed. I walked up to her calling 'hey little kitty' and then BANG she ran so fast out of the little gap and into the pen. I followed her and after a few minutes chase I ended up catching her with my bird net. She was so vicious and was trying to bite me, hissing none stop. So I put her in a cat cage in the dark to let her relax and calm down. I came back to check on her every so often but she kept trying to bite and attack, wouldn't let me even try to open the cage because every time I put my hand near it she would jump up against the wire to try to get me so she clearly wasn't a pet and was born in the wild.

I walked out this one morning recently and Holly was laying down not herself but I was in a rush to go to work so I thought maybe she was just a bit down because of the heat. That night I got home and Holly is still in the same spot, so I jumped into my car and took her straight to the Animal Hospital where they confirmed that Holly was pregnant which I already knew but they also said she has some sort of infection with a very high temperature.

I had to leave her there over night so they could give her antibiotics and put her on the drip due to dehydration. The Vet called me the next morning saying that she was worse and they needed to do several blood tests with X-Rays because they had no idea what sort of infection she

had. Three days went by and every day the Vet would call me to let me know how Holly was doing. When I went to visit her at the hospital she looked terrible. She lost weight, didn't want to eat, wouldn't even walk or stand and her breathing was so bad that it was like she was gasping for air. I was then told they think the infection has now caused her to have fluid in her lungs so they had to do more X-Rays and Blood tests. The results showed she did have fluid in her lungs but they still didn't know why and what sort of infection it was.

Then like a miracle on the 4th day the Vet called me up and said Holly is better you can take her home tomorrow morning. I was so happy jumping for joy until the next morning I was called again by the Vet, this time he said Holly has taken a turn for the worse and suggested to put her to sleep or intensive care which will cost you \$1000.00 or more plus the \$560 you already owe for the past few days. I had a few hours to think about it and called them back and said this isn't good enough, one minute you tell me she is better and the next you tell me she needs to be put to sleep, also you can't tell me what sort of infection she has, the prices for blood tests and X-Rays seem to keep going up, do you guys know what you are doing?

I then told the Vet what my Mum told me we can't afford to put Holly into intensive care so can you please just give her an extra strong dose of Antibiotics for a day or so because we don't want to put her down. The Vet after arguing with us agreed and said ok we will do that but I'm telling you now that realistically it won't help her but at least it will give you a couple days to re think your decision.

The very next morning I called to see how Holly was and the news I got was amazing. They told me she is walking, eating and very alert so she will be able to come home. They said her temperature was back to normal and the fluid in her lungs disappeared and that her babies might still be alive but they weren't sure. Holly came home and started to eat again and in a few weeks she gave birth to 5 adorable kittens. Holly proved the Vet wrong and beat the odds never giving up, I didn't give up on her either.

The kittens are 12 days old now and I look at them all and think if I had listened to the Vet Holly wouldn't be here and neither would these 5 little angels.




This is a Q and A section to help get those important questions answered.


Q1 I recently purchased a dagger that I originally thought was a lighter weight resin, but on further examination, found that it is definitely coated in metal, or perhaps made of a very lightweight metal. It "sings" loudly when tapped against another metal object, whereas my resin daggers do not make this same melodic sound. It also feels like metal when you touch it, although it is painted gold over the metal parts and not "shiny" like you would expect metal to be. It is common knowledge and I believe verified by the Black Wolf (Roger) that the prop dept. used four different materials for their weapons: Foam, resin, rubber and metal. However, most metal weapons I have handled are definitely quite heavy. My dagger is clearly metal but not very heavy; in fact, not even as heavy as some of my resin daggers. Can anyone shed any light on what this may be made of or the process of electroplating? I thought in order to electroplate an item, the surface of the object to be electroplated also had to be metal for the charge to be conducted and the process to succeed. The dagger's origins are 100 percent genuine and it is from the set (it is a Livia style dagger) but this is the first time I have owned a dagger made of this material. Any thoughts? **MORGAN**


